The team will be working on construction projects at the church and homes while participating in various ministry projects in the morning and day and leading training conferences for men/women's ministries, family ministries, and children and youth events during the evenings. The approximate cost for each team member is around \$250.00. This includes lodging, transportation and some of the materials that will be needed for home repairs.
