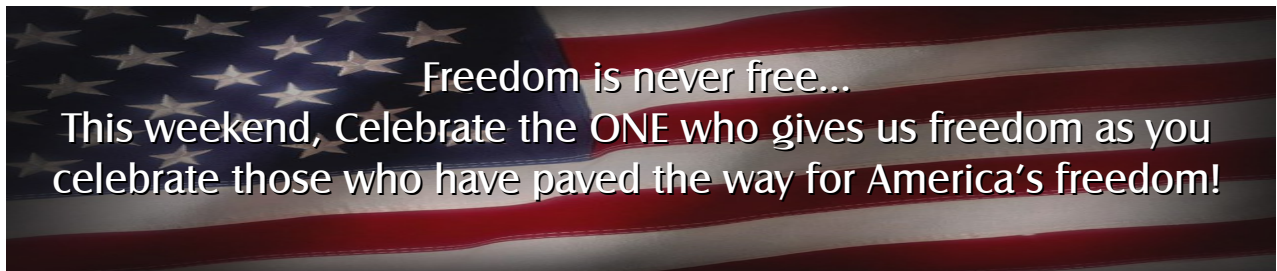

*A team of 21 church members will be traveling to a small town outside Gallup New Mexico to minister to a Navaho church and her community. The pastor is a Native American who has continued to minister faithfully in starting and growing a small congregation committed to reaching the Navaho tribe. The team will be working on construction projects at the church and homes while participating in various ministry projects in the morning and day and leading training conferences for men/women's ministries, family ministries, and children and youth events during the evenings. The approximate cost for each team member is around \$250.00. This includes lodging, transportation and some of the materials that will be needed for home repairs. If you would like to help defray the cost for members going, contact the church office or Randall. Funds given will be distributed among the group to lower the per person costs.*
