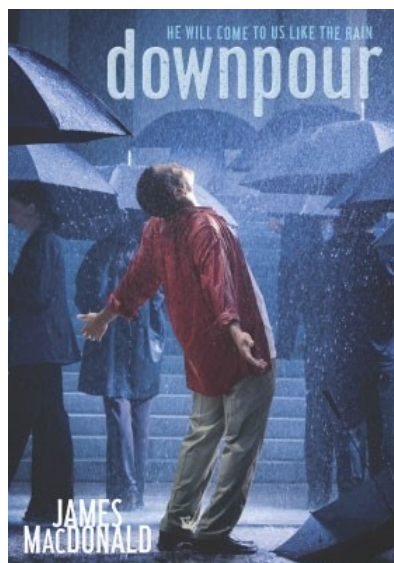

The newest addition will be those who are involved with the Invitation Counseling. This is a new ministry designed to assist those who are making a decision at the end of a worship service or at an event and need just a moment longer than a hymn. The “etc.” is added to the list because we are confident that as we mature and grow in Christ there will be opportunities to express that growth in different ways and service to Him.
