### **Summer Game Nights...**

There are a couple of special nights coming up in June and July for the church family to get together and to build community and fellowship and play. Mark your Sunday afternoon calendars for June 27 and August 1. These dates may seem far off, but we'll be there before you know it!

**There are 3 Realizations that will change your life**, and have the potential to change the life of someone you tell... of course, you have to believe these 3 truths adamantly and invest a little time to speak about them. Actually, you may already know these truths and even have acted upon them.

**1 – Jesus is who He said He was**

**2 – What the Bible says is true is true**

**3 – Everybody is going to be somewhere forever**

Interesting enough, although most folks here at First Baptist Church of Crestview would agree on those three items, we live in a world, even a community, where the majority of people are very uncomfortable committing to those truths. While they may have no problem with you believing, to push them into making some kind of decision becomes offensive. And yes, the Gospel is offensive. Are you ready to offend someone?

## HOW IMPORTANT IS YOUR TIME?

### HOW IMPORTANT IS THE TIME YOU SPEND INVESTING IN THE LIVES OF OTHERS?

If you could teach only 52 truths from God's word in one year, which truths or lessons would you teach? Before you answer, be warned that you will have 52 days in which to teach; and of those 52 days, you are allowed only 60 minutes... or less depending on when the student arrives. And, what if those truths were to be learned by a 6 year old; would you teach them the same truths and in the same way as you would a 13 year old?

Parents obviously lead and teach more than 52 truths a year. Our church ministry leadership can come alongside parents and reinforce those truths during the time we spend together at 171 Hickory Ave. As an example, in Deuteronomy 5, Moses reminds us of the 10 commandments, and in Deuteronomy 6 he shares how often we are to teach them to the children. Interesting enough, he never suggests what to teach if you get "bored" with the same ole 10 lessons. Keep teaching; keep applying. For how long? Before you settle on a time line, answer the following: How often did you have to tell your children to brush their teeth before they did so without being reminded? Or, did you just say "use good hygiene?" No, first, you start with small doable tasks and show what "hygiene" is... then you move on to other things such as bathing, and then the importance of actually using soap. Sure, it sounds simple, but doesn't God remind us often to do the little things so He can show us how to do the big stuff?

52 hours. 52 lessons. You know what, there's 52 Sundays in the year... and 52 Sunday School lessons... 52 Kids Stuf, 52 Big Stuf, ...yikes, there's even fewer hours of children's missions and music. Can you spare 52 hours?

The Bible is far from boring. It's exciting. It's alive. It's the Word of God. Kids need it. Youth need it. Adults need it. If you are bored with the "same ole lesson" then use that wonderful imagination to discover areas where you've not yet applied the Word. His word speaks to all circumstances.
